

# CRAIG BCA POOL LEAGUE





## DATES & INFO

This session will end on April 29<sup>th</sup> / 30<sup>th</sup>. If we have an even number of teams again this year we will not have play-offs and all teams will play in the City Tournament. If we have an odd number of teams we will make the last week of play our play off week.

The top two teams will have a first round bye at City Championships. The good news is that everyone still has a great opportunity to make it to Nationals in Las Vegas!! Remember anyone can go to Nationals, not just the City Championship Winners.

- ✚ Last day to add new players to your teams is Feb 5<sup>th</sup>.
- ✚ Remember you must qualify with 8 weeks of play to participate in City Championships or National Championships. Captains please be aware of who needs to play in order to qualify.
- ✚ City Championships dates are May 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> 2018.
- ✚ Last day to notify operator if your team is going to Vegas is May 21<sup>st</sup>
- ✚ Second place team has the opportunity if 1<sup>st</sup> place chooses not to go, but must notify operator by May 30<sup>th</sup>.
- ✚ If no team goes the national fees will remain with the league for next year.
- ✚ Team 8-Ball Events in Vegas are: 8-Ball = July 2018
